Don't Delay – Enter Today !

On 25th October HRC will stage the 2020 Edition of the B & H Endurance Races on the old Pukekohe circuit. Not the loop but straight through on the back straight. There will be a 100 mile race for modified cars and the 500 mile for standard cars.

The **FLEETLINE 500** race will be over 500 miles (or 6.5 hours - whichever comes sooner) and there will be no limit on the number of drivers per car and pit stops will also be un-limited, no minimum times or limits of when to stop.

As part of the this meeting we will also run a shorter 100 mile race – The **Store Rite 100** for cars that comply with the IPC rules which allow more modifications though with a minimum lap time of 1.14sec on Hampton.

Entries are open at www.motorsportentry.com and will be on a first come, first served basis. Maximum of 46 entries in each race.

Entry Process:

- Decide which race you want to enter - 100 miles or 500 miles
- Make sure that your vehicle is eligible by reading the rules
